

Other Fundraising Ideas...

- Make a brochure or info sheet with your personal story of why you want to evangelize other young people. Keep it simple and to the point. Use your computer skills to dress it up. Use the sample brochure found at www.netcanada.ca/partnership.
- Make pseudo business cards and have them with you at all times to hand out.
- Have a fundraising party/dinner/breakfast. Charge \$10 at the door and raffle of door prizes donated by local businesses.
- Ask K of C or CWL to host a fundraising breakfast for you after Sunday Mass
- Talk to a local business owner and ask if you can sell hotdogs outside their building (A group of alumni did this and Wal-Mart matched their hotdog sales)
- Auction off services (babysitting, yard work etc.)
- Advertise in your diocesan newspaper
- Work at the concession stand at a parish or school event with the proceeds going to your year with NET.
- Host a cribbage/bridge/euchre tournament
- Auction off a cow (or something else...) - seriously, someone did this once – be creative!
- Dunk Tanks (especially if you can get your Priest/Youth Minister/Deacons to get dunked)

Note: While events are great at PR and sharing what you'll be doing with a group of people, they are not always the most effective at fundraising. They take a lot of time (and people) to organize and often involve cost to put them on. While a good option, face-to-face asks, letters, and phone calls are often more worth your time and efforts.
