Missionaries share their experience at NET Training

How has training been for you so far...?



Kristin Scott —

"I've always found it a lot harder to make friends with girls rather than guys, so I naturally gravitate towards a group of men over women. Since this was a reality in high school, I fully expected it to be the same on NET. Man, was I proven wrong! As soon as I started to develop this relationship with the Virgin Mary, I found myself for the first time in my life *desiring* sisterhood. I had a newfound appreciation for the beauty of femininity in all the forms it presented itself in the women here! I've since made such good, deep friendships with many of my co-missionary ladies, rooted in our common faith and love for the mission of evangelization. Through her intercession, I've been so blessed!"



James Pereira —

"So far, Fall Training has been unbelievably amazing. I remember a particular moment of conversion for me happened during an evening of prayer called "The Heart of Worship." The band was playing a beautiful song called "So Will I" by Hillsong UNITED and a particular lyric caught my heart. The line was "You're the One who never leaves the one behind" and in that moment the scripture verse from Luke 15 about the Good Shepherd (Christ) who leaves his flock of 99 sheep to go after the 1 sheep that was lost, rejoicing when He finds it. I realized that for so much of my life I considered myself to be one of the 99 who had never gone astray but I was in fact the one that Jesus came for."



Egan Weiler —

"During the first week of training I was kneeling in adoration, and at one point I was gazing at the monstrance, and I felt as if God was smiling down at me. Later on in prayer ministry, one of the leaders who was praying for me stopped his train of thought and said he felt called to tell me that he also felt that God was smiling down on me. I took it as a sign that God was glad I was here and wanted me here."



What are you excited for this year...?



Daniel Perera —

“Apart from what God is doing in my own life it is quite evident that he is also using the people around me to make his presence known. It’s beautiful to see how God is working in the hearts of the new missionaries this year. As a second year missionary it can be so easy to slip into the mindset of knowing it all; having already lived a year on the road, yet seeing the first year missionaries give their hearts completely and fully to God each day is a good reminder that God is still not done with me yet. There is so much more he wants to reveal to me if only I can keep abandoning myself to him each day.”

Kyle Cronin —

“I have grown so close to all my brothers here on NET and have discovered what it truly means to be a Man of Christ. In fact, I have grown closer to these men than any friends I’ve had in the past and that’s because Christ is at the center of it all.”



Catherine Shortell —

“I’m so excited for the upcoming year of ministry in Keewatin le Pas. I have the feeling I could never be fully prepared for what I’ll experience. Everyone who has experience in Keewatin has expressed similar sentiments of inspiration, heartbreak, and hope. I think I will learn a lot from the community there, and feel so blessed to be given the chance to be part of such an exciting, influential mission.”



Avery Burrowes —

“But all of this training is not simply for our sake; it is all to prepare us to share these blessings with the young people of Canada. For those of you who may not know, my team will be heading to the archdiocese of Keewatin- Le Pas which covers most of Northern Manitoba and Saskatchewan. We will be working primarily with youth from the first nations/ indigenous communities in these areas. Many of these are broken and hurting communities that have experienced many trials over the past decades: from economic collapse to substance abuse issues, the legacy of residential schools and mental health crises. But God has not forgotten His children! It is His mission we share in. I am filled with hope knowing that we can bring the Good News to so many currently living in darkness. Young people need to hear that God has created them for a purpose, that their lives have meaning; that they are loved and so worthy of love that God has shed His blood on the cross to set them free from sin and bring them into relationship with Himself to experience life with Him that is unending joy and hope. This is the message we proclaim.”

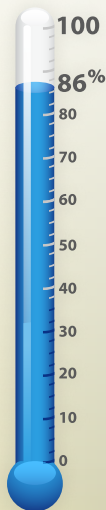
