NET's response to COVID-19

It's unprecedented to say the least; never in the last 25 years of NET Canada have we had to end the mission year early. It was a hard decision to recall our teams and close out the year, but in hindsight it was obviously the right call. As hard as it was to say goodbye to our latest missionaries, we have quickly become used to the new reality we are starting to call Ministry Unusual.

This new reality of isolating and physically distancing initially caught everyone off guard, but it didn't take long for our staff to seek out what God wanted us to do next. THE BEGINNING OF FAITH

How Team 1 changed the lives of a student population of 50% non-Catholics

Catholic schools face a growing population of students who identify as non-Catholics, varying anywhere from “spiritual but not religious” to atheism. How are Catholic school educators supposed to engage these students in the Catholic faith and balance the regular school curriculum? This was the challenge that Chris Dugdale, Superintendent at the *Catholic Independent Schools Diocese of Prince George, BC* faced. With nearly a 50% non-Catholic student population Dugdale knew he needed to do something drastic to give his students an opportunity to encounter

Christ and his message of love. Enter NET team 1.

“(The) NET team visited our large Diocese in Prince George in January 2020 and worked with our grade 6-9 students in 8 schools, offering dynamic and memorable full day retreats”, states Dugdale.

With the high amount of non-Catholic students, Team 1 had a difficult task laid before them: 1) win these young people over enough so that they’ll be open to listen to their testimonies, and 2) to be, perhaps, these students’ first witness of Christ’s love. They never expected this kind of change.



My absolute favourite part was when the small group leader came and prayed for each member of their small group. It was good for me because I was going to have surgery on the same day and it took my mind off of it and when I had surgery I wished that it was the morning because I felt so connected to God. This NET retreat was amazing and really helped me in my faith as I was going through a hard time.

We are continuing our ministry in an online format. 18 Discipleship Groups are currently being run for these areas:


- **Brooklin, ON: 2**
