We, the NET retreat team for 2022-23, have had an amazing start to our ministry so far!

October 2022

Even though we have only just begun our ministry, we have already had many incredible experiences, and encountered over 700 youth in the first month alone! A large number of youth have shared with us how they've encountered God during our retreats. A few retreatants told us after one retreat that they wanted to start practicing their faith themselves by praying daily, reading the Bible, and attending youth group. There was also one youth in grade 11 who started a retreat by saying that she wasn't sure whether she believed in God or not; however, by the end of the retreat, **she not only believed in Him but also said she wanted to commit to a relationship with Him!**

One of the most important parts of our retreats is prayer ministry, when we get to pray with each of the youth. We have been so blessed to witness the Holy Spirit moving at these times; indeed, many of our retreatants have had personal encounters with Jesus! Some have experienced His love for them, and were so overwhelmed that they could not hold back their tears. One retreatant even felt that the burden she was carrying at the time was lifted off her shoulders.

As a team, we have grown considerably in the first month of our ministry. Getting the chance to pray together daily, drive together for countless hours and spend time together on our days off have made us grow close to each other; it's crazy to think that we've only known each other a few months! As we continue our ministry in the coming weeks, we are very excited to grow closer as a team and travel to parts of the country we've yet to encounter. However, most of all, we are thrilled that we will be able to encounter even more teens and share with them our faith and our joy.

Know that you are in our prayers, and we ask that you continue to pray for us too. We look forward to sharing more of the amazing works of God in the months to come!



A couple days ago, we had our first senior youth night. We had a group discussion, and one of the questions I asked was "What is one spiritual goal that you'd like to set and how are you going to go about doing it?" Some of them answered that they'd want to increase the amount they pray, start praying more. One girl shared that she'd like to pursue the saint that she picked on all saints day, to continue to pray to that saint and grow in holiness through their intercession. She also shared that the one big goal that she has in life is to "Get to heaven, to meet Jesus and give Him the biggest hug!" It was so beautiful seeing this group of young people on fire for their faith!

Encountering God

There are many steps along the way to a relationship with Jesus Christ. Each step is a "yes", a movement towards Jesus. Here are some stories of steps being taken by young people this year.

At the start of the retreat, one of the girls in my small group was unsure whether she believed in God or not. By this last small group, however, after all the experiences of the retreat, she not only believed but wanted to engage in a relationship with God.

He then asked me for a commitment card, so that he could grow closer in a relationship with God. I noticed therefore that the youth grew a lot in his faith, even in the space of a single day.
